Year 2 Key Information

This is the book they will have been reading in guided reading during the week. It should be returned to school on a Tuesday with their reading record and homework.

Maths / English This homework will be set in their on a Friday to be completed by the following Tuesday. The homework may take the form of phonics, spellings, handwriting or maths activities.

How can you help at home?

In Maths, we are consolidating basic skills and it would be very useful to have this reinforced at home. Topics such as counting in 2s, 5s and 10s as well as number bonds within and for 10 are always useful reminders when practised at home. Other topics which we will cover during the year such as time and shape are part of our everyday lives and it would benefit the children to be familiar with them.

We would appreciate it if you could look at the words your child has been given to spell and discuss the meanings of the words this will enable the children to learn to use them in context.

The children are also asked to read at least 3 times outside school. Please check their reading records and write a short comment each time you hear them read. Most of all, enjoy their books with them and show them your love of reading! We aim to instil a lifelong love of reading in all children!
